

DATABASE OF WORLD PULP & PAPER PRODUCERS

NLK Associates has developed a database which includes well over 95% of all pulp and paper mills worldwide, along with details of their location, ownership and installed capacities for each grade. It also includes estimates of market pulp consumption at each paper and board mill, as well as changes, both confirmed and trade directory, but a fully can be analysed in countless

Coverage of the Database (September 2005)

2692 mills producing 358 million tonnes of paper and board
357 mills producing 70 million tonnes of market pulp and DIP
1126 mills producing 174 million tonnes of integrated pulp and DIP

All mills are entered into an ACCESS database. Menu pages enable users to focus quickly and easily on the precise grades, companies, countries or regions in which they are interested, and to view, print and download a growing range of reports.

Information Included

For each mill:

- company
- parent
- country and region
- mill notes
- paper & board capacity by grade
- integrated and market pulp capacity by grade
- estimated market pulp consumption
- investment plans

Each grade of pulp, paper or board can be analysed by mill or parent company, by country, region or world totals, at the click of the appropriate buttons. For example:

- market pulp consumption by parent company in Asia
- uncoated woodfree paper capacity by mill in the US
- market bleached softwood kraft pulp capacity in Eastern Europe
- market pulp consumption in tissues in Western Europe
- containerboard capacity in North America
- world market DIP capacity by region
- recycled paper consumption in China

- consumption of mineral fillers and coating pigments in South America
- top ten producers of each grade (table and bar chart)
